1. Purpose

This course provides individuals with training and information on the risks of fire in the workplace or home and the subsequent actions to be taken should a fire occur.

FW is for all occupants of a workplace. Workplace evacuation exercises are designed to ensure the ability of staff and occupants to effectively and efficiently evacuate a premise in response to an emergency.

3. Entry requirements

Before commencing FW training, a person must:

- Be able to understand and speak the English language sufficiently well to coordinate and communicate with others.
- Be capable of undertaking training to carry out emergency drills.

4. Course duration

These courses are timed to suite the individual requirement of you the customer.
