

BEEN IN A CAR CRASH?



To help reduce danger to road users and manage crashes more efficiently, you may no longer have to wait for police at a crash site in NSW.

Only call **Triple Zero (000)** for police to attend if:

- anyone is trapped or injured
- police are needed to direct traffic or deal with hazards
- any drivers appear affected by alcohol or drugs
- a bus or truck needs to be towed, or
- anyone involved has failed to exchange details.

For all other crashes, police do not need to attend. If a vehicle has been towed away, call the Police Assistance Line on **131 444** after you leave the crash site to make a report.

**Remember, if you are involved in a crash,
keep safe and move away from traffic.**
