COVIDSafe Guidelines

Principles

- The NSW RFS is continuing to monitor and respond to the COVID-19 situation, and COVIDSafe practices are to be followed at Service activities and locations.
- Organisers of activities and events, and those responsible for the management of locations, must ensure COVIDSafe measures are in place, including suitable sanitisation and cleaning, to protect the health and safety of those attending.

Actions and Advice



If you are feeling unwell, do not attend NSW RFS activities or locations. Stay home and get tested. Follow the [NSW RFS COVID-19 Response Action Process](#) for suspected or confirmed cases of COVID-19.



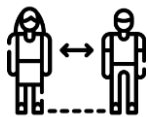
Maintain a high standard of hygiene – wash your hands regularly with soap or use sanitiser, and cover any coughs and sneezes.



Ensure cleaning is carried out at NSW RFS locations, including general, preventative, and targeted cleaning. Check the Fact Sheet on [Site and Appliance Cleaning](#).



Consider if you can hold your activity remotely to help limit face-to-face interaction.



Practise physical distancing. This means maintaining a 1.5 metre distance wherever possible, and following limits on group sizes such as one person per four square metres.
