


Canobolas BFMC Bush Fire

The **aim** of this BFRMP is to reduce the adverse impact of bush fires on life, property and the environment.


reduce the number of human-induced bush fire ignitions that cause damage to life, property or the environment;
manage fuel to reduce the spread and intensity of bush fires while minimising environmental/ecological impacts;




This BFRMP identifies the assets that are considered by the Canobolas BFMC and community to be at risk from bush fires, assesses the bush fire risk to each asset and assigns treatments designed to mitigate the risk. Assets in the BFMC area identified as requiring treatments are listed in the assets table. Other assets within the BFMC area that were assessed as not requiring treatments within the life of this plan are listed in the appendix to the BFRMP
