

Who Should Attend This Training

All occupants of a workplace should undertake regular evacuation and response training and those who are assigned specific responsibilities in emergency procedures, such as wardens, should undergo specialised skills development courses.

Workplace evacuation exercises are designed to ensure the ability of staff and occupants to effectively and efficiently evacuate premises in response to an emergency.

Course Format

This course uses a mixture of audio-visual presentations, group discussion and interactive practical participation.

Course Outcomes

- Identify and understand workplace emergency plans and equipment
- Respond to emergency reports, signals and warnings
- Anticipate the further development of emergencies
- Assist with post initial response

Course Duration and Location

Course duration is approximately 4 hours. The course is designed to be delivered in your workplace and it is tailored to address the most likely emergency scenarios to occur within your organisation. The course can be modified to suit your individual needs and circumstances.

Competencies

The course covers the competency 'Operate as Part of an Emergency Control Organisation' and has been developed to cover emergencies in workplaces as considered in the Australian Standard 3745-2010.

WARDEN AND EVACUATION TRAINING

This course provides individuals with training and information regarding the risks of fire and emergencies in the workplace or home and the subsequent actions to be taken should a fire occur.
