Llandilo Bush Fire Assessment

5 November 2016

The NSW Rural Fire Service (NSW RFS) has completed a preliminary assessment of the damage caused by the bush fire at Llandilo in Sydney's west yesterday.

Build Impact Assessment teams have confirmed a number of properties have been damaged by the fire.

This includes:

- Four houses damaged
- One care facility damaged
- One shed destroyed
- One shed damaged
- A number of vehicles damaged or destroyed

No homes have been destroyed.

Eighty other properties in the fire affected area have been inspected by Building Impact Assessment teams and have no damage.
