Upcoming Events in 2016

Event 1 – 'HR in Focus' – Take control, back yourself

A day dedicated to the development of workforce planning, specifically, identifying potential new programs, avenues and opportunities for young professionals to enter the Service. During this session, the forum will discuss how the Department can better engage with young professionals and with potential staff who may live in remote or rural areas. An overview would also be provided of some of the other networks within the DJ, allowing people the opportunity to connect.

Event 1 – Department of Justice Corporate Planning Workshop

The Justice YPN, in conjunction with OPOD, held a corporate planning workshop for staff aged 34 years and under. Over 70 staff attended the workshop at the Parramatta Justice Precinct Offices enabling young professionals from different Divisions were able to reflect on the draft Corporate Plan and work together in a range of interactive activities and discussions.



Event 2 – Department of Justice Business Planning Workshop

As a result of the successful outcome of Event 1, Peter Connelly, Deputy Secretary, OPOD, invited the Justice YPN to present to the Secretary and the Department Executive during the Business Planning workshop held on 5 May 2015.
