If a fire starts, immediately put your bush fire plan into action.



For your survival, do not be in bush fire risk areas.



The safest option is to avoid bush fire risk areas.



Avoid travelling to bush fire risk areas.



Stay safe by going to a safer location early in the morning or the night before.
