Areas where prescribed burning is planned are identified as strategic fire advantage zones, ignition management zones or land management zones. Each zone type has strategies to appropriately address the risks to the asset types and values. Areas where vegetation management is more intensive, typically through mechanical clearing are identified as asset protection zones and firebreaks. The fire history in and around the region is described as previous burnt area.
